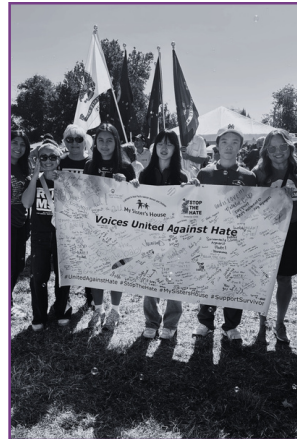

SURVIVOR STORY

"I came to My Sister's House feeling nervous, scared, and confused after being referred through CPS following a violent relationship that led to me losing custody of my children. As both a human trafficking and domestic violence survivor, I never imagined how much these classes would change my life.

Through the program, I learned to recognize the warning signs of abuse, understand power and control, build healthy relationships, and strengthen my self-worth. More importantly, I found my voice, regained my confidence, and became a better parent.

Today, I have not only reclaimed my power—I have also reunited with my children. I am deeply grateful to My Sister's House for helping me heal, grow, and believe that I will never again accept abuse or control in my life. Organizations like My Sister's House truly change lives, and my family and I will always be thankful."

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Key Highlights

Fundraising Growth

Raised **\$630,000+** through donations, events, and fundraising campaigns—a 26% increase from the previous year.

Diversifying Revenue

Strengthened and diversified our funding through a combination of government grants, private philanthropy, corporate and community partnerships, events, and earned revenue.

Revenue Growth

Increased total revenue by 4.7%, from \$2.14 million in Fiscal Year Ending 2025 to \$2.25 million in Fiscal Year Ending 2026, strengthening our financial foundation and capacity to serve survivors.

Investing in Survivor Housing

Increased our investment in an additional property, expanding our capacity to serve survivors while strengthening MSH's long-term assets and organizational stability.

Strategic Community Investment

Continued investing in relationships with nonprofits, government entities, and businesses that share our commitment to building a safer, healthier community.
